

Save money on your prescriptions with home delivery.

Home Delivery allows you to get a 3-month supply for the price of 2 copays.

Choose convenience and savings by using a mail-order service. A 90-day supply of the medications you take regularly can be delivered directly to your home for less. This service offers:

- Three ways to order refills: online, by phone or through the mail.
- Get up to a 90-day supply of medications at one time.
- Choose to get a text, email or phone call letting you know when your order is received, and your prescriptions are mailed.

To start saving, grab your new member ID card and set up an account with one of the following home delivery services:

Already using home delivery?

If you currently use OptumRx for home delivery, you will need to switch your prescriptions to one of the mail-order pharmacies listed above. Switching is easy. Here's how:

- Select the pharmacy you want to use for home delivery from the list above.
- Set up your new account one of two ways:
 - Visit the website.
 - Call the toll-free number.
- Have your new Blue Cross Group Medicare Advantage member ID card handy. You will need to provide your member number when you set up the account.
- Ask your provider to send a 90-day prescription plus refills for up to 1 year (if applicable) to the home delivery pharmacy you have chosen. Most providers can do this right from their computer.
- If your provider uses paper prescriptions, you will need to fill out a form and send the paper prescription to the pharmacy by mail. Find the form and directions on the pharmacy's website or call their toll-free number for assistance.

Once you set up your new home delivery account, bookmark the pharmacy's website and save the toll-free number to your phone.

Don't run out!

Order refills before 12/31/24 to ensure you have enough of your medication on hand before the new home delivery service starts.
